

## Sharing God's Vision

When was the last time you had trouble communicating with someone? It happens to all of us at some time, and to many of us, lots of times. Maybe it's because you didn't understand the other person's language or culture. Maybe it's because a word can mean different things to different people.

There's an old joke which used to told amongst the personnel at the Joint Services Base in Canberra that the different branches of the Armed Forces have trouble operating jointly because they don't speak the same language. For example, if you told Navy personnel



It is estimated that there are a little over 7,000 languages in the world. Given the difficulties we experience communicating between people who supposedly speak the same language, it is little surprise that the potential for misunderstanding due to cultural differences and misinterpretation increases exponentially between peoples whose languages don't share a common historical foundation.

How then do we communicate the love of god and promised eternal life to those who don't share a common language or culture? In Acts 2:4 the disciples "were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them" and they were able to communicate with other peoples in their own languages (as distinct to how some people now interpret "speaking in tongues"). Sharing God's vision need not involve learning a foreign language, but learning to speak to others in a way they can understand. For example, the style of language needed to communicate with a 16 year old drug addicted homeless teenage girl is radically different (a foreign language?) to that which you would adopt if speaking to a 90 year old retiree. With patience, god's blessing and through accepting the holy spirit, we can all learn to share god's word. As Christians that is our duty, our obligation and our joy.


In addition to the Enablers the Leadership Team are seeking volunteers to:


### Yoy's Drop In!
