

Your Place Is Behind Jesus (Mt 16:21-28)

Origen of Alexandria, also known as Origen Adamantius (AD 185—AD 253), was an early Christian scholar, ascetic and theologian. He was a prolific writer, producing about 2000 treatises in multiple branches of theology. One of them, the treatise On the First Principles systematically laid out the principles of Christian theology and became the foundation for later theological writings and he also significantly contributed to the development of the concept of the Trinity. Sadly he died as a result of injuries inflicted by the Romans during the Decian persecution when he refused to perform the sacrifices demanded by Emperor Decius. You Can't Take the Cross!

A church wanted to improve attendance at their worship services, so they hired a highly regarded advertising agency to come in. study their situation, and make recommendations. The ad agency did their research and then suggested to the church leadership team that they should get rid of all the crosses in the church. Their reasoning was that the crosses might send a negative message to prospective young worshipers!

Now, I'm sure that in its history, that advertising agency has come up with some brilliant ideas; but that's not one of them! We can't get rid of the cross! We don't want to get rid of the cross. The cross is the dramatic symbol of our faith, hope, love, and forgiveness. The cross is the powerful reminder of God's sacrificial and redemptive love for us, and the cross is the constant signal to us of how God wants us to live and love today; as sacrificial servants. We are not called to be prima donnas, we are called to be servants. We are called to take up the mission of Christ and to emulate the servant spirit of our Lord.
