This Is Easter

You probably do not remember the name Nikolai Ivanovich Bukharin. During his day he was as powerful a man as there was on earth. A Russian Communist leader he took part in the Bolshevik Revolution 1917, was editor of the Soviet newspaper Pravda (the name of which means truth), and was a full member of the Politburo. His works on economics and political science are still read today. There is a story told about a journey he took from Moscow to Kiev in 1930 to address a huge assembly on the subject of atheism. Addressing the crowd he aimed his heavy artillery at Christianity hurling insult, argument, and proof against it.



An hour later he was finished. He looked out at what seemed to be the smouldering ashes of men's faith. "Are there any questions?" Bukharin demanded. Deafening silence filled the auditorium but then one man approached the platform and mounted the lectern standing near the communist leader. He surveyed the crowd first to the left then to the right. Finally he shouted the ancient greeting known well in the Russian Orthodox Church: "CHRIST IS RISEN!" En masse the crowd arose as one man and the response came crashing like the sound of thunder: "HE IS RISEN INDEED!"

I say to you this morning: CHRIST IS RISEN! I am convinced! I have faith that Christ was dead and he was buried. That I believe. But, this too I accept as true: He rose from the dead and will come again in all His glory. This is Easter.

During World War II, an Australian Navy submarine was stuck in the mud on the bottom of the harbour in Sydney. It seemed that all was lost. There was no electricity and the oxygen was quickly running out. In one last attempt to rescue the sailors from the steel coffin, the navy had a ship equipped with divers anchor directly above the damaged submarine. A navy diver went over the side of the ship in one last desperate rescue attempt. The Trapped sailors heard the metal boots of the diver land on the exterior surface, and they moved to where they



thought the rescuer would be. In the darkness they tapped in Morse code, "Is there any hope?" The diver on the outside, recognizing the message, signalled by tapping on the exterior of the sub, "Yes, there is hope."

This is the picture of our dilemma as we worship this glad Easter Day. Humankind is trapped in a dreadful situation. All around us are people who are running low on hope, and they look for a word from beyond offering it to us. This world in which we live is plaqued with war, famine, disease and destruction from manmade and natural disasters. The more we try to rescue ourselves the more we seem to fall behind. Many wonder; is there any hope? But there are those who know where to find the answers. All they have to do is read the Gospels-the answers are there for those who seek them.
