The Enemy of Jesus

Some years ago a refuge from Africa decided to earn some extra money by performing as a comedian in a local pub. On the night of his first performance there was a large cheerful crowd and he started off by saying: "On my first shopping trip, I saw powdered milk-you just add water, and you get milk. Then I saw powdered orange juice--you just add water, and you get orange juice. And then I saw baby powder, and I thought to myself, "What a country!"

Naturally he was joking but we make these assumptions about Christian Transformation - that people change instantly at salvation. Some traditions call it repentance and renewal. Some call it Sanctification of the believer. Whatever you call it most traditions expect some quick fix to sin. According to this belief, when someone gives his or her life to Christ, there is an immediate, substantive, in-depth, miraculous change in habits,

attitudes, and character. We go to church as if we are going to the grocery store: Powdered Christian. Just add water and disciples are born not made.

Unfortunately, there is no such powder and disciples of Jesus Christ are not instantly born. They are slowly raised through many trials, suffering, and temptations. In many passages, including today's reading (Mk 8:27-38) Jesus is up against a formidable foe, and in the end this foe may posses more power than he does. But the foe is not Peter and it's not the Sanhedrin or Pontius Pilate, or Rome. This formidable foe is not even Satan himself. The powerful enemy of Jesus is our quest for positions of rank and status.

To address the confusion Jesus pulls his disciples together and brings them before a crowd. Then in front of the crowd he corrects the disciples aspirations for privilege, rank, and power and he gives them this simple little directive: You must take up your cross and follow me. It was a huge challenge then and it remains so today. Humility is one of the hardest lessons to learn and yet to be faithful to the teachings of Christ we must practise what we profess to believe in. How heavy is your cross?


Congregational General Meeting
